- Transplanting
- Garden end-of-season care
- Soil preparation
- Cold protection

Fall Clean-up

- Remove unwanted plants
 - Weed control
 - Dead & diseased plants
 - Unwanted insect habitat
- Prepare for spring gardening
 - Soil test & amendments
 - Mowing & mulching
 - Watering

Annual Plants (flowers & vegetables)

- Harvest when ripe
 - Use protection from frost
 - Remove plants before ground freezes





- Cover crops
- Mulch

Perennial Plants

- Divide & transplant springblooming plants
- Plant spring bulbs & garlic
- Move houseplants inside
- Collect native flower seeds

Trees & Shrubs

- Limit any pruning
 - Storm damage
 - Dead or dying
- Add new woody plants in early fall
 - Water until ground freezes
 - Mulch area well
- Install winter protectors
 - Windbreaks & bindings
 - Tree guards & trunk wraps

Lawn & Turf

- Apply new seed & sod
- Weed control & fertilizers
- Aerate & dethatch
- Mow as needed until temperatures below 45°F

Wildlife Support


- Minimize clean-up
 - Leave perennials stems
 - Keep leaf piles near trees
- Add a (heated) water source
- Install a birdfeeder













General Winter Garden Care

- Equipment & seeds
 - Take inventory
 - Purchase new
- Houseplant care
- Start (long-season) seeds
- Prune trees & shrubs

- Inventory
- Tools
 - Clean & Sanitize
 - Sharpen

Sources of Seeds

- Seed catalogs & garden stores
 - Higher prices & more varieties
- Seed libraries & seed swaps
 - Low cost & fewer varieties
- Save your own
 - No cost & fewest varieties













Annual Plants (flowers & vegetables)

- Tip-over outdoor containers or store indoors (garage)
- Select & purchase seed
- Start seeds
 - Indoor growing
 - Winter outdoor sowing

Perennial Plants

- Houseplant care
 - Watering
 - Cleaning
 - Propagation
 - Fertilizing
- Purchase perennial plants (will ship when ready)

Trees & Shrubs

- Avoid shaking off snow
- Prune in early spring
- Purchase new woody plants (will ship when ready)
- Remove winter protectors
 - Windbreaks & bindings
 - Tree guards & trunk wraps

Lawn & Turf

- Minimize foot traffic during thaws
- Watch for damage
 - Vole trails
 - Snow mold
 - Salt damage
 - Dead spots







- Insects
 - Avoid disturbing plant debris
- Birds
 - Provide food & water
 - Regularly clean & sanitize feeders
- Larger wildlife
 - Feeding not recommended







Pest & Damage Control

- Watch for pests in homes
 - Houseplant pests
 - Rodents
- Be careful of over-watering plants
