## **Buckthorn Busting**

<u>Buckthorn</u> is a species that was originally brought over to our country from Europe as a small shrub to be used as a hedge in the home landscape in the 1800s. How did folks know at that time that this species would become invasive, taking over natural areas and preventing native trees and shrubs from thriving?

#### Fall into Winter

Did you know there are steps you can take to ensure the health of pollinators next spring and summer in your yard and garden beginning this fall? Here are 3 tips to get you started:

- 1. Trim your perennials back to 18" to create new homes for stem-nesting native bees next summer.
- 2. Make a pile of fallen leaves

somewhere on your property so bumblebees have a place to hibernate over the winter.

3. If you transplant perennials in your yard, place them together to create a large mass of flowers that will be easy for bees to find.
